Career Path Services is committed to supporting our program participants and partners during this time of crisis and stress due to the COVID-19 outbreak. We are working closely with applicable fund sources and state authorities to advocate for the needs of our participants and partners to ensure their safety.

At this time, communication is still key.

If you are directly impacted by a school, daycare, or worksite closure as a program participant or host site partner please contact your local Career Path Services representative to report. If you are feeling sick or feel you are at high risk of getting sick or caring for someone in a high-risk category, we encourage you to stay home and communicate with your local Career Path Services representative.

We have been given some flexibility in reporting extended excused absences, including the ability to continue paying our program participants a portion of their lost wages due to unscheduled worksite closures for this public health crisis.

We continue to monitor the situation daily and will adhere to local and state closure recommendations as they become available. We are requesting staff to conduct orientations, intakes, classes, and workshops over the phone and/or online via video conferencing platforms. We have also asked staff to limit travel and postpone non-essential meetings as well as stay home if they are feeling sick.

We sincerely wish all our partners and participants well and hope everyone takes the precautions they feel are necessary to protect themselves and their families. We will continue to provide applicable updates locally as things change.
